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Salt Dough Recipe

Ingredients:

- 1. 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2. 1 cup salt
- 3. 1 cup cold water

Step 1

Mix flour and salt together in a bowl. Slowly mix water, a few tablespoons at a time, into flour mixture until dough is smooth and easy to handle. Knead dough for 10 minutes and let rest for 20 minutes.

Step 2

Preheat oven to 120 degrees C.

Step 3

Form dough into desired shapes and arrange on a baking sheet.

Step 4

Bake in the preheated oven until dry and hard, about 2 hours. Allow to cool completely.

Method



Make cupcakes and icing and keep about 3 tbsp of the buttercream separate and colour the remaining icing green. Ice 10 cupcakes with the green buttercream then decorate nine of these with smarties, keeping one green cupcake aside.



Mix a little cocoa powder into the remaining buttercream or until desired chocolate colour is achieved then ice the remaining two cupcakes before decorating with brown Smarties.



For the star on top; you can either ice a star-shape onto your remaining green cupcake, or top with a star-shaped cookie as we have. Top this with a little green icing and one pretty red Smartie.



Arrange the cupcakes into a tree shape then finish with the two brown cupcakes and you're done!



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Ingredients

- large candy canes
- small (12g) Milky
 Way chocolate bars
- 100g chocolate melts
- Tiny Teddy biscuits, honey flavoured
- Mini M&Ms, red only

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Method



Place chocolate in a glass bowl and melt in the microwave for 1 minute. Stir until melted. Place a layer of baking paper down to sit your sleighs on. Peel plastic off candy canes. Place on the sheet about 3cm apart.



Spoon a little melted chocolate on the back of a Milky Way and sit the Milky Way on the candy canes. Adjust the canes so the hooks are standing straight up.



Using a sharp knife, cut legs off a Tiny Teddy biscuit. Dab a little melted chocolate on the cut edge.



Sit the Tiny Teddy on top of the Milky Way and hold until firmly attached.



Dot a little chocolate on a red Mini M&M and stick it on the face of the Tiny Teddy biscuit.



5cm sticks and dab a little chocolate on the bottom of each stick and place on Tiny Teddy head as antlers.

Working with Children Checks

Warrandyte Kindergarten is very fortunate to have a large number of friends and family volunteer to help us with our activities at the kindergarten, including help during our kindergarten sessions. This involvement is something that we very much value as part of our kindergarten. However, more helpers are always greatly appreciated!

All of our helpers require a Working with Children Check card. If you do not have a card, it is a very easy process that is confidential and free.

Step 1: Complete an online application form at www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au.

Step 2: Finalise your application at an Australia Post outlet. This will include presenting one acceptable proof of identity document such as a driver's licence or passport. Australia Post will take your photo for the card free of charge.


